ACSILs' Message on the Treaty on the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons

We, “the Association of Comprehensive Studies for Independence of the Lew Chewans (ACSILs)”, and all the peace-loving and peace-seeking Lew Chewan peoples would like to celebrate and welcome the Treaty on the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons that has been passed with 122 nations in favour on 7 July 2017 at the United Nations.

We understand the importance of this treaty very much. After the achievement of our Lew Chew independence movement, which is decolonization, demilitarization, and restoration of our sovereignty as a nation, we are very much sure that our newly independent nation of Lew Chew, say, Republic of Lew Chews, will sign and ratify the Treaty on the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons.

In that sense, our Lew Chew independence movement is also a movement of prohibition of nuclear weapons. After the restoration of our sovereignty, the future “Republic of Lew Chews” will surely take the initiative in comprehensively prohibiting nuclear weapons, with the goal of leading towards the total elimination of all the nuclear weapons in the world.

According to the US Department of Defense and the National Security Archive, there were 1300 nuclear weapons deployed on Okinawa Island in 1967. Based on many evidences, such as a secret agreement entitled “Agreed minute to Joint Communique of United States President Nixon and Japanese Prime Minister Sato issued on November 21, 1969”, we, unfortunately, have to believe that the US military forces still equips nuclear weapons in Okinawa and that the Japanese government permits it tacitly. We cannot silently overlook this situation.

Again, we, “the Association of Comprehensive Studies for Independence of the Lew Chewans (ACSILs)”, and all the peace-loving and peace-seeking Lew Chewan peoples would like to celebrate and welcome the Treaty on the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons.
