E aloha ia mai oukou, a e maluhia hoi i Ke Aupuni o Hawaii, ko Hawaii pae aina.
Grace and peace to you from the Kingdom of the Hawaiian Islands.

This memorandum is to introduce the leaders of ACSILS to the Honorable Robert Hernandez Kajiwaru who has been appointed by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Hawaiian Kingdom as a Special Envoy for the promotion of peace, friendship, trade, culture and mutual support for shared aspirations of the Lew Chew Islands and the Hawaiian Islands.

This appointment is confirmed by the Cabinet Council of State, acting in Regency under lawful authority in accordance with the Constitution and laws of the Hawaiian Kingdom and the Law of Nations.

Special Envoy Kajiwaru is charged by our government to represent the interests of the Hawaiian Kingdom and its people; and to find ways in which we may mutually assist each other in our peaceful pursuits of asserting our respective national sovereignty.

We trust that ACSILS will extend all necessary courtesies and considerations to Special Envoy Robert Hernandez Kajiwaru in the performance of his mission.
